Admission and Attendance

3131 – District Attendance Area Transfers

A parent or guardian may request that his or her child be allowed to attend a school outside his or her attendance area within the White River School District.

Intradistrict transfers may be requested in writing on the appropriate district form and submitted to the Superintendent and/or his or her designee for review.

Intradistrict transfers may be granted if:

- 1) A financial, educational, safety, or health condition affecting the student would be reasonably improved as a result of the transfer.
- 2) Attendance at another school in the district is more accessible to the parent's place of work or to the location of child care.
- 3) There is some other special hardship or detrimental condition affecting the student or the student's immediate family which would be significantly alleviated as a result of the transfer.

Intradistrict transfers will be granted on a first come, first served basis subject to:

- 1) Available space in the grade level or classes at the building in which the student desires to be enrolled.
- 2) Available appropriate educational programs or services to improve the student's condition as stated in the request for transfer.

In all cases where an intradistrict transfer is approved, the parent(s) will be responsible for transportation, unless there is room on an already-established district bus route and permission is obtained from the transportation department.
