Board Organization

**1240 - Committees**

Legally, board members can act only as a group. As individuals, they have no legal right or power. Board action can be taken only when in formal session.

Hence, all committees, temporary, standing, and committee of the whole can function only to study proposals for future action or make comparative analyses to determine recommendations to be presented to the total board for action in regular session or in a properly publicized meeting.

At the request of the majority of the board, the president shall create temporary committees and appoint board members to such committees. The committee's purpose and terms will be established by a majority vote of the board.
