



**CENTRALIA SCHOOL DISTRICT  
BOARD POLICY #2178  
TRAFFIC SAFETY EDUCATION**

The district shall provide traffic safety instruction for eligible students. A fee shall be assessed to cover those costs. In addition to offering a traffic safety program that meets state standards, the program must be self-supporting.

The board directs the superintendent to implement procedures dealing with program supervision; curriculum development; student enrollment criteria, including but not limited to grade level of student, age of student and enrollment status of student; student progress; and collection and refunding of student fees, including provisions for accruing money for future traffic safety program needs or refunding students when student fees.
