



**CENTRALIA SCHOOL DISTRICT
BOARD POLICY #2408
CREDIT FOR OUT-OF-SCHOOL LEARNING**

Credit for learning experiences conducted away from school or by persons not employed by the School District:

It is the policy of the Board that credit toward high school graduation may be granted for school planned learning experiences primarily conducted away from the facilities owned, operated, or supervised by the School District or conducted primarily by individuals not employed by the School District. School planned experiences such as, but not limited to, travel study, work study, private lessons and educational programs, sponsored by governmental agencies may be accepted for credit upon compliance with procedures established by the School District. Rules which permit the granting of credit for such out-of-school learning activities will be adopted by the School District Board of Directors and be available to students, parents, the public and representatives of the Superintendent of Public Instruction upon request.

The Superintendent is directed to prepare rules and regulations to carry out the provisions of WAC 180-56-041 and submit them to the Board of consideration and adoption.
