

INSTRUCTION

TRAFFIC SAFETY EDUCATION

The district, or another authorized service delivery agent, may provide traffic safety instruction for eligible students. A fee shall be assessed to cover those costs which are not reimbursed by state funds.

The operator of the program, if any, will implement procedures dealing with program supervision; curriculum development; student enrollment criteria, including but not limited to grade level of student, age of student and enrollment status of student; student progress; and collection and refunding of student fees, including provisions for accruing money for future traffic safety program needs or refunding students when student fees exceed the unreimbursed cost of the programs.
