

COCURRICULAR AND EXTRA CURRICULAR PROGRAMS

Non-athletic activities throughout Sheridan County School District One shall be governed by the following regulations:

1. A pupil must meet eligibility criteria as established by the activity's sponsor and approved by the principal.
2. A pupil must be in attendance in classes at least half a day of the activity in order to participate in the activity.
3. Alternate transportation. Students must ride to activities in school-approved transportation. Alternate transportation is not encouraged and should be approved on a limited basis. In order for a student to not return by school transportation:
 - a. Prior to a trip: the parents/guardians must complete Alternate Transportation Form (EEADA-E) prior to the activity.
 - b. During a trip: the parents/guardians may personally pick up their child by signing them out with the activity sponsor.
