

Curriculum Resource Adoption

Responsibility for the review and selection of curriculum resources rests with the teachers, principals, and curriculum director according to the District's Long-Range Plan. Students and parents may be asked to serve on curriculum selection committees.

Resources can be materials that will be used with students, materials that will be used by the teacher for planning and instruction, or professional development that will enhance the knowledge and skill of teachers.

Resource adoption guidelines:

1. Align with state learning standards and school district outcomes.
2. Support research-based, powerful instructional practices.
3. Support and enrich the core curriculum but does not replace the core curriculum.
4. With consideration given to appropriate readability for the student involved.
