

Response to Student Injury or Illness

The board recognizes that school staff are responsible for providing first aid or emergency treatment in case of injury or illness of a student. To that end, the board encourages school staff to become certified in first aid. Further medical attention in non-emergency cases is the responsibility of the parent/guardian. School staff will notify the parent/guardian of students who suffer (more than minor) injuries, illness or physical trauma at school or at any school-sponsored activity as soon as practicable.

The superintendent will establish procedures to be followed consistent with this policy.
