Advanced Placement

To qualify as an advanced placement credit course, the following requirements must be met:

1. The subject matter of the course is dealt with in greater depth than similar courses in the regular program and at a level consistent with requirements to successfully compete in the advanced placement testing program.
2. Advanced placement courses must be approved by the superintendent of his designee.
3. Courses carrying advanced placement credit shall be designated by the "Advanced Placement" or "AP" in all course catalogs, registration materials, and related information given to students and parents.
4. Advanced placement courses shall be identified as such on grade reports, transcripts, and other school records which contain this information.
