

Non-Resident Students

Non-resident pupils may attend the Richland School District schools when the following conditions are met:

1. It is possible for the district to accommodate the student.
2. The district of the pupil's residence agrees to release all state apportionment funds for the child to the Richland School District.
3. Approval by the district superintendent or designee. Students who live in a school district that does not operate a secondary program shall be permitted to enroll in the secondary schools of this district as if they were residents in this district. Assignment to a school will be made considering the student's educational needs and circumstances at the school, i.e., course availability, class size, etc.
4. The district shall claim state financial reimbursement for the students as provided by law.
