Overview: Washington State Achievement Index

- The Washington State Achievement Index is designed as a unified state and federal system intended to meaningfully differentiate among schools.
- It is a snapshot of a school's performance based on statewide assessments. We can compare how a school performs in reading, writing, math, science, and graduation rates.
- The achievement index is a joint project between the State Board of Education and the Office of the Superintendent of Public Instruction.

Overview: Washington State Achievement Index

The goals are to:

- To provide a fair and consistent measurement of Washington's public schools.
- To present a clear picture of how schools and districts are performing.
- To demonstrate improvement over time and highlight closing achievement gaps.
- To tell us more, in an easier-to-understand way, than the federal "No Child Left Behind" Act's requirements for Adequate Yearly Progress.
- Show how well low income and non-low income students perform.
- Measure not only how many students meet state proficiency standards, but also how much and how quickly students are learning.

Overview: Washington State Achievement Index

The Washington Achievement Index uses 3 *performance indicators*:

- Proficiency
- Growth
- Career and College Readiness

The composite Achievement Index is the 3-year mean of the most recent annual values of these indicators.

The index for elementary and middle schools weights the Growth indicator at 60% and the Proficiency indicator at 40%. For high schools, the weighting depends on the year and which data are available.

Schools must have met the 95% participation rate in state assessments.

Overview: Washington State Achievement Index

Proficiency

A combination of proficiency in English Language Arts (or reading and writing in previous years), mathematics, and science. Subjects are weighted equally.

Growth

A combination of median student growth percentiles in English Language Arts (or reading in previous years) and mathematics, weighted equally.

Career and College Readiness

For all student groups and targeted subgroups, a combination of the adjusted 5-year graduation rates, the percent of students performing at or above a college-and career-ready cut score on the 11th grade SBA, and the percent of students earning high school credit in a dual credit program or earning a state or nationally recognized industry certification.

Achievement Index Award Winners

State Superintendent Randy Dorn and State Board of Education Chair Isabel Muñoz-Colón announced that seven Shoreline schools are among the 258 Washington schools to earn 2015 Washington Achievement Awards. The award recipients represent the highest performing schools in the state based on three years of academic information as reported in the Washington Achievement Index.

“The Achievement Awards recognize schools and educators making a difference in student outcomes. Award recipients are schools that have made measurable progress helping students prepare for college, career, and life.”

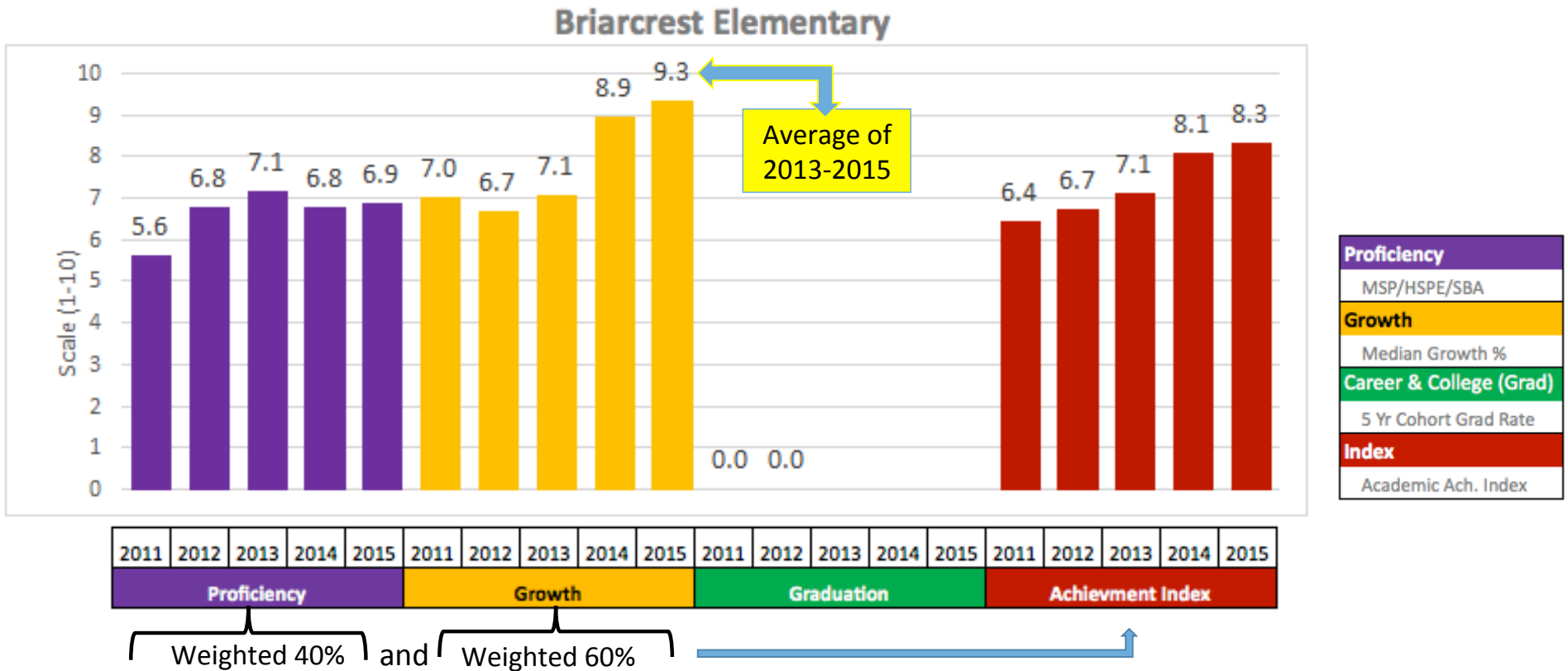

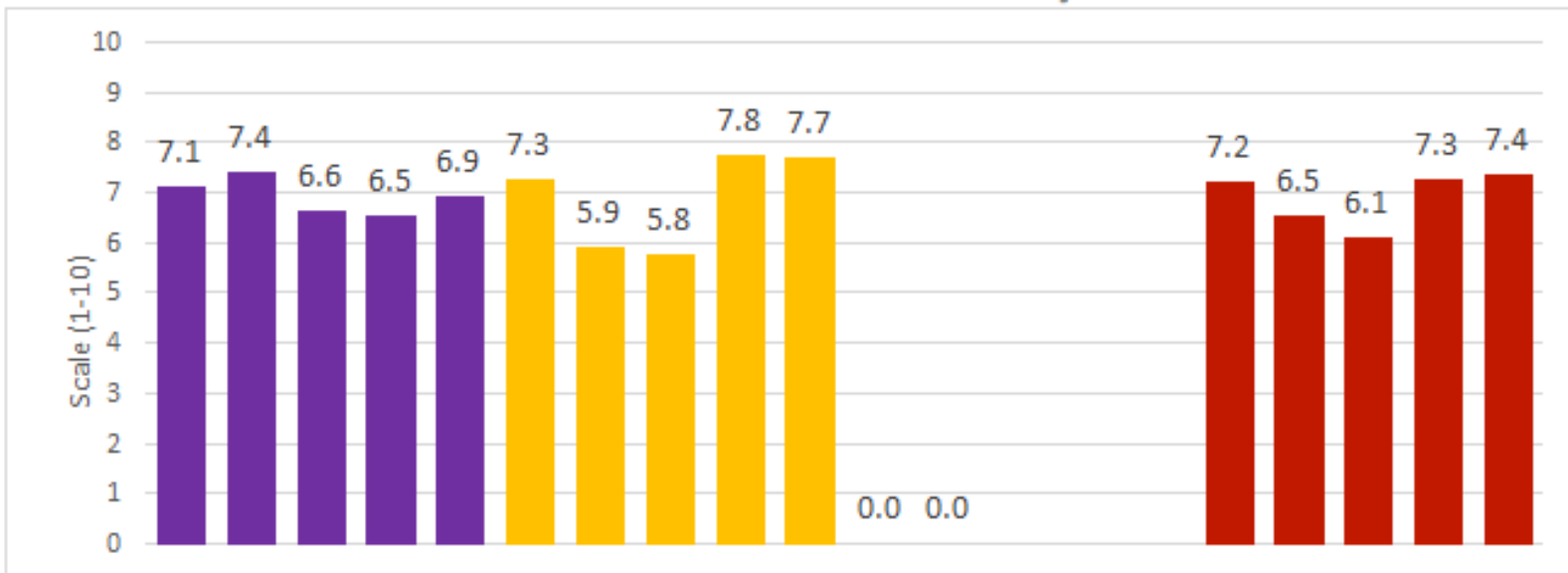
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The weighted 3 year averages combine reading, writing, math, and science scores on state assessments.

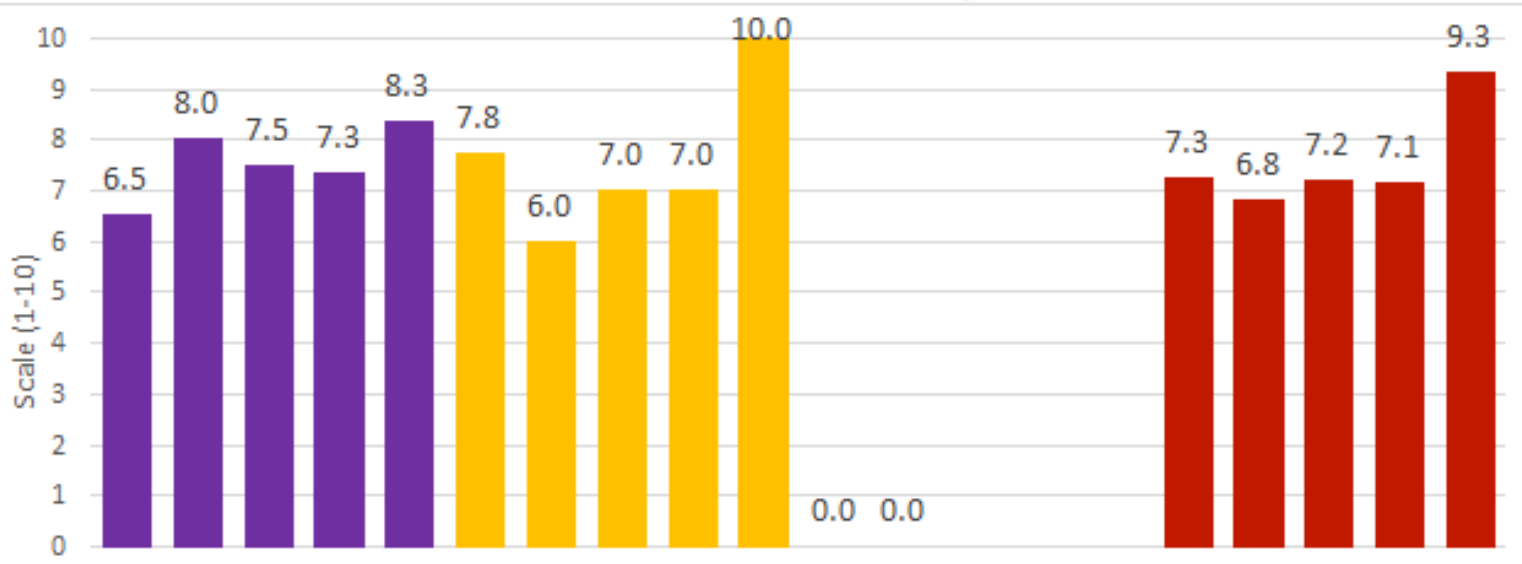

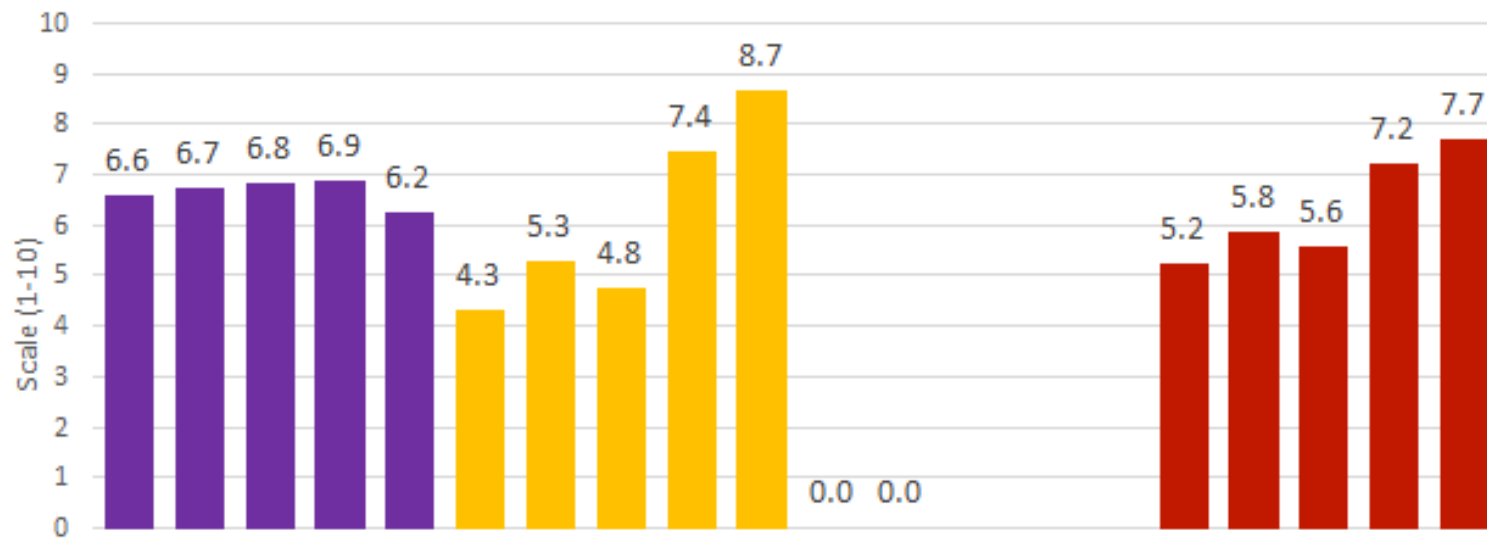


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Echo Lake Elementary School

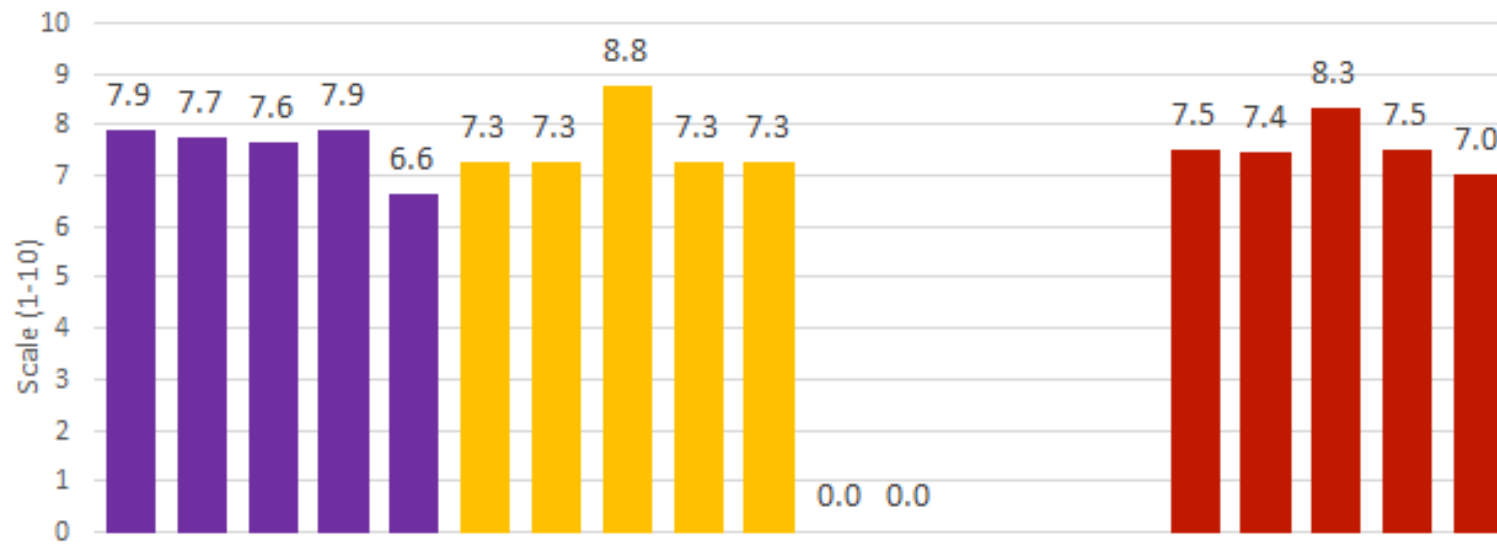


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Highland Terrace Elementary

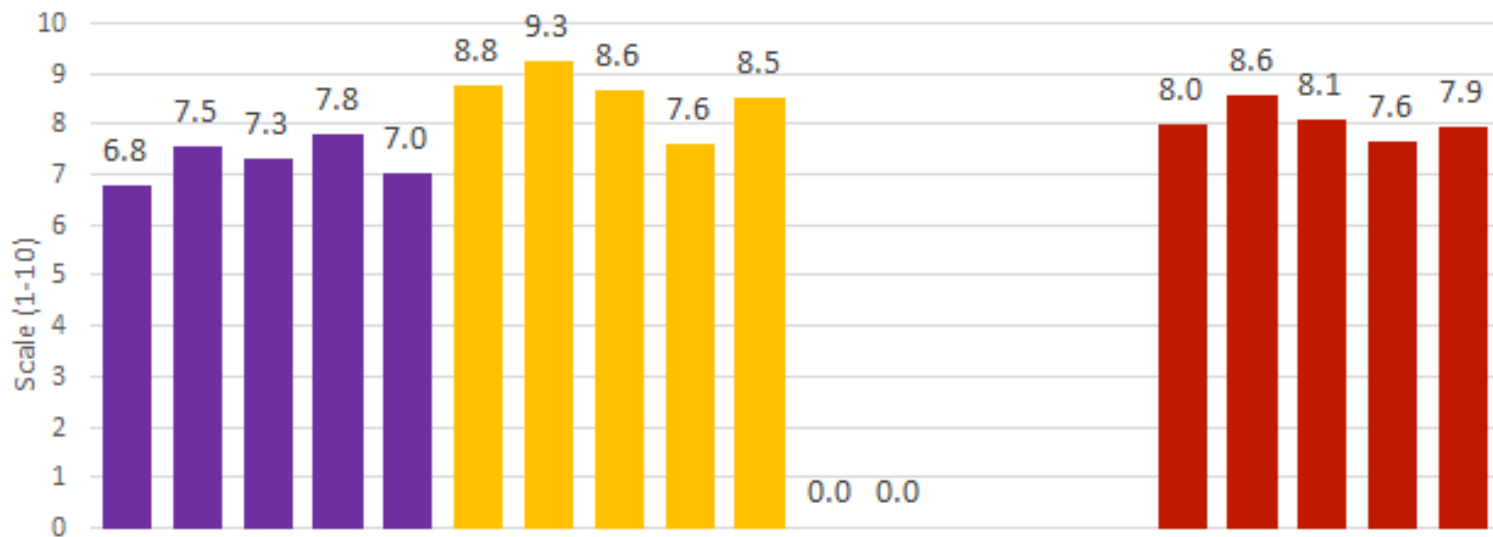


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Lake Forest Park Elementary

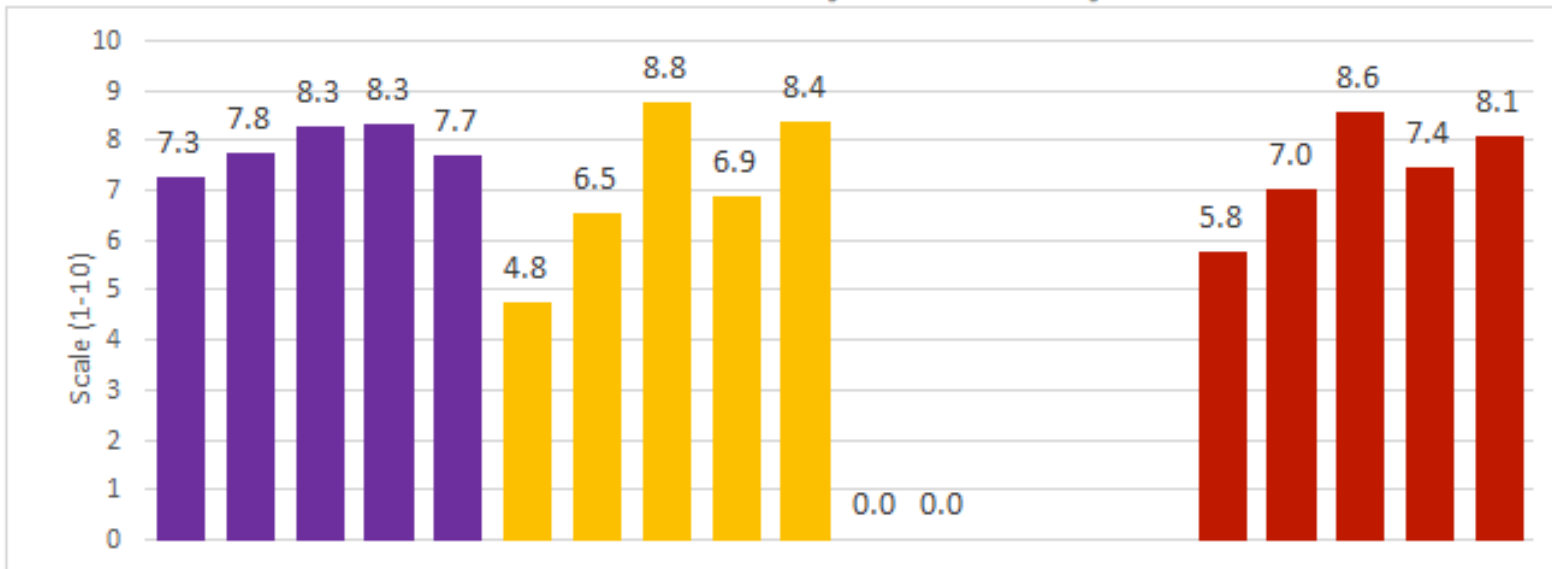


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Melvin G Syre Elementary

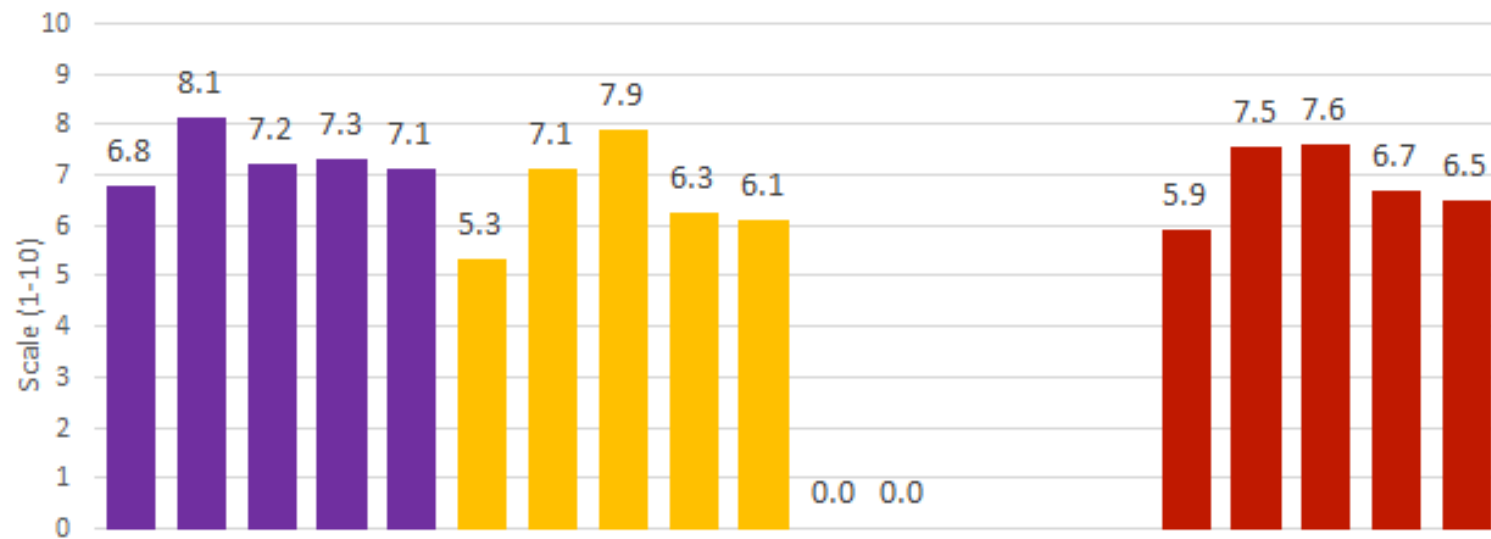


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Meridian Park Elementary

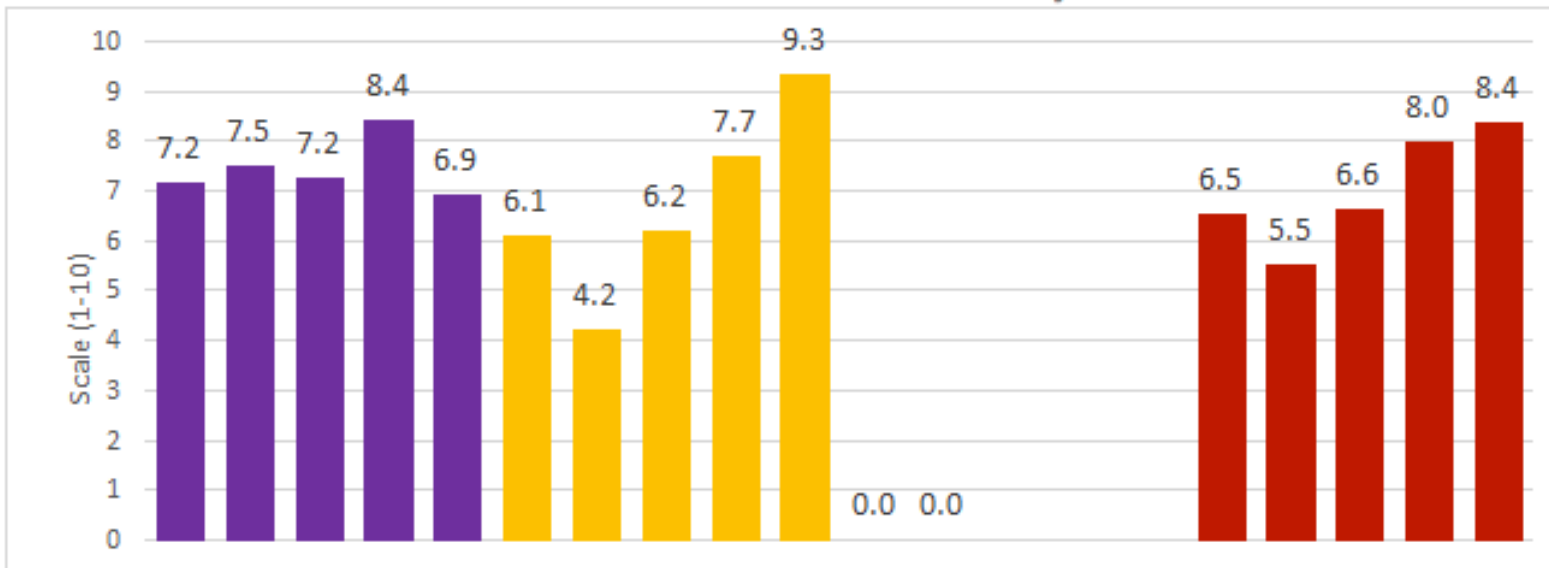


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Parkwood Elementary

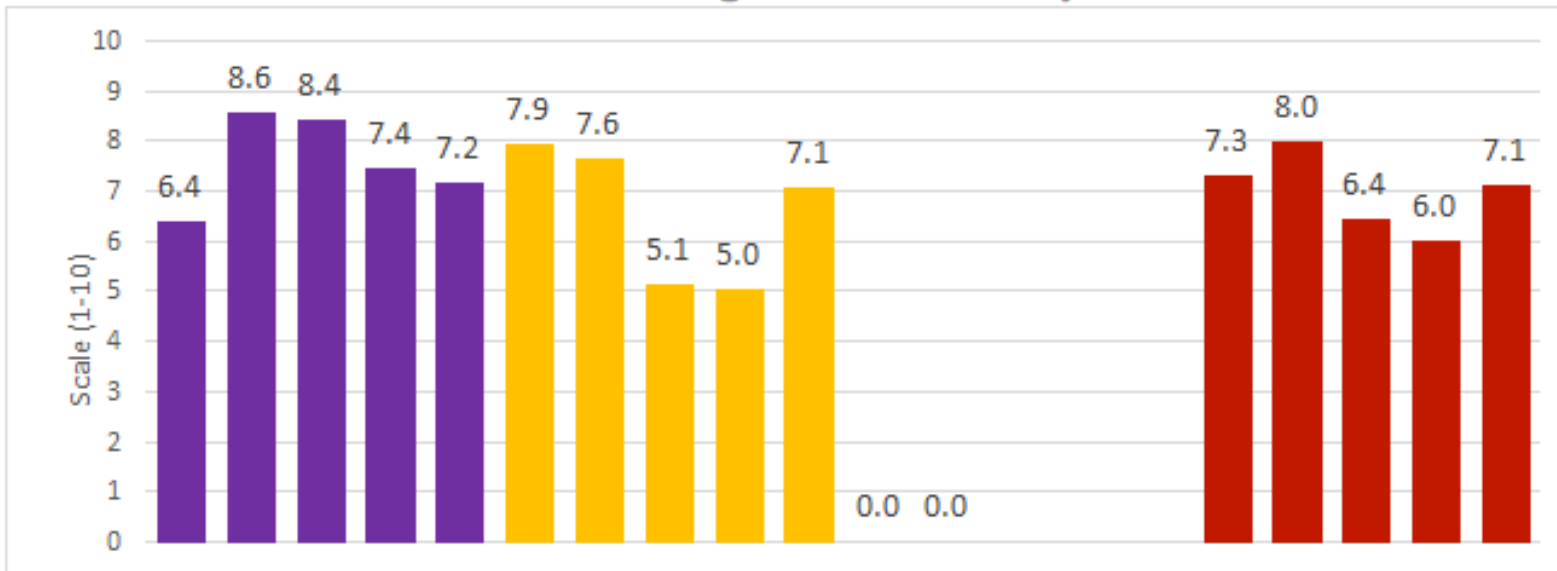

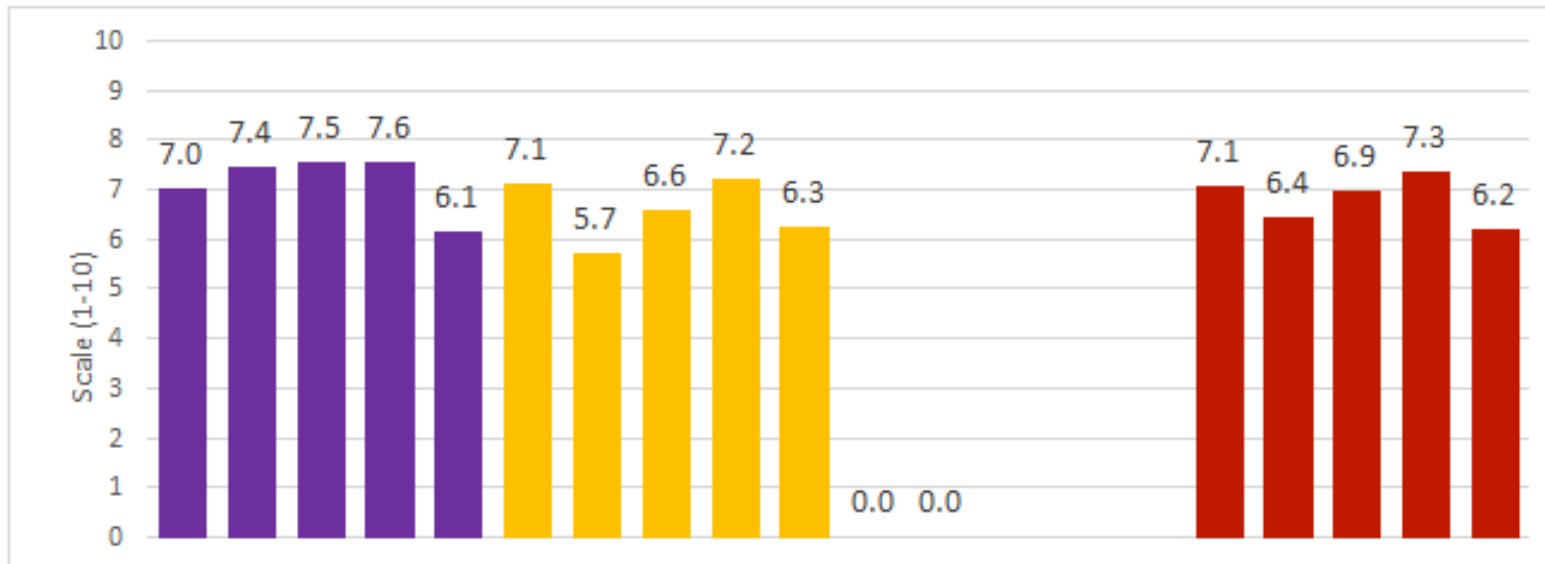


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Albert Einstein Middle School

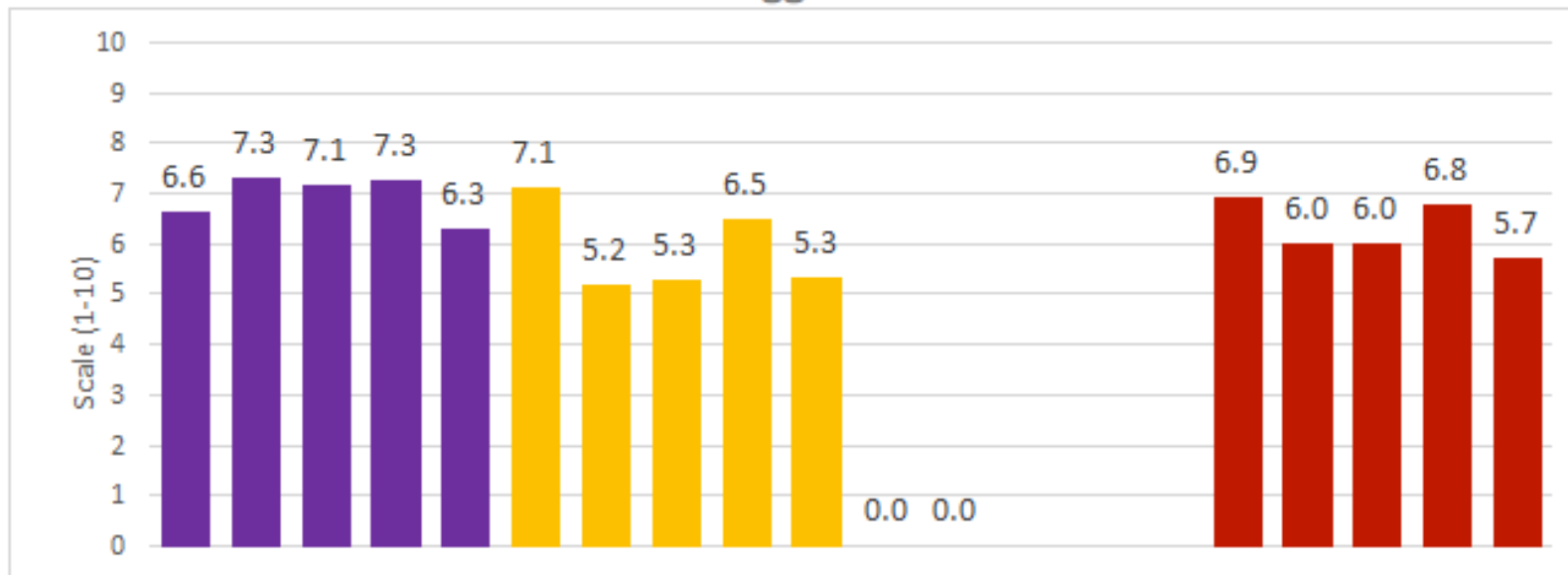
