

Reardan Elementary Principal's Report September 27, 2017, Board Meeting

- Our District will again participate in “**The Great Washington Shake Out**,” October 19th, at 10:19 A.M. This is a state and nationally coordinated earthquake drill.

- **Our Emergency Practice for poor air quality**: When our air quality reaches 150, we have indoor recesses and PE. Students enter the building immediately upon arriving at the school doors from the buses.

- **SIP (School Improvement Plans)**: We reviewed our school's achievements on last year's action plans and have been working on this year's action plans. We will have action plans for reading, math, science, and social studies this year.

- **September 25th Waiver Day**: All elementary teachers teaching math and their aides participated in a webinar exploring the on-line resources and materials for our new MyMath curriculum. The staff then collaboratively explored the vast resources available on the website. The 3rd-5th grade ELA teachers worked on the Wonders' website resources.

During the afternoon, Dwight shared parts of the PowerPoint from the Suspending Suspensions workshop, updating staff on new laws regarding suspensions and expulsions. This presentation and subsequent discussion served as a great lead into the PBIS (**Positive Behavioral Intervention and Supports**) workshop presented by Chad Hand, interventionist for Deer Park School District. We then discussed **PAX (Good Behavior Game)**, sharing successes, challenges, and how this and PBIS support each other.

- **MAP Testing (Measures of Academic Progress)**: We have started MAP testing, assessing all K-5 students in reading, math, and language. Our school will finish the second week of October. Teachers will share MAP results with parents during conferences.
