c. Student Handbook Amendment (Weapons and Terroristic Threats)

“Wyoming law requires the expulsion of any student who is in possession of a weapon on school grounds or within a school bus for a period of one (1) year. This expulsion may be modified on a case-by-case basis depending on the circumstances of the violation. Accordingly, any student with a weapon in his/her possession shall be subject to immediate suspension for up to 10 school days and expulsion for such period of time thereafter as is appropriate under the circumstances. This includes weapons left in vehicles driven to school by a student. Likewise, any terroristic threats made against a school, person, or any entity within the school district will be subject to the same consequences. In all cases involving weapons or terroristic threats, the School District will contact law enforcement. The School District may provide students with school work during such period of suspension/expulsion and allow the student to continue with classes to the extent deemed appropriate.”
