13. COMMUNICATIONS

- a. Board Members

Board Member Freya McCamant thanked the community for the strong support given to the District over the years for bonds and parcel taxes. Ms. McCamant pleaded to the community for continued support in the future for the renewal of the parcel tax.

Board Member Lizet Cortes wished the principals and everybody good luck with the new school year and said that she is looking forward to visiting and supporting the school.

Board Member Kimberly Hines said that she echoes the appreciation for the District, parents, and new leadership. Ms. Hines shared that the Board did a full-day the retreat on Sunday, August 4, that will give Board Members a stable base to understand each other and follow best practices. Ms. Hines stated she is looking forward for other study sessions and working with the community.

Member Mary Beth Alexander welcomed everyone to a new school year. Ms. Alexander said she enjoyed the retreat and feels this is going to help the Board work together.

President Sophia Layne welcomed Superintendent McPhetridge, Assistant Superintendent Leticia Bhatia, and Interim Chief Business Official James Crawford. Ms. Layne also welcomed new Farallone View Principal Anne Cildir. Ms. Layne stated the Board Meeting on Monday, August 5, provided a productive conversation about the financial overview of the District and the implication for our school district as result of the insufficient funding at the state level.

b. Superintendent

Superintendent McPhetridge said he is excited coming to the District as an outsider to see the great facilities work at Cunha School and that it is important to celebrate even knowing that it caused pain to the district. Superintendent McPhetridge said he is excited to see the great work done at Hatch and Pilarcitos campuses. Superintendent McPhetridge stated that the District will be reviewing and updating the district Facilities Master Plan to continue working on making sure to deliver on the promise made to taxpayers about the bond.

Superintendent McPhetridge shared that the Board voted 5-0 for a replacement parcel tax that represents \$1.6 million. Superintendent McPhetridge said that, as district employee, he cannot advocate but he can provide information about it. If the parcel tax does not pass, the district will have to cut an additional \$1.6 million. Superintendent McPhetridge also shared that the district is working with the San Mateo Office of Education County to make actionable cuts by the first interim in December because of the inequitable funding from the State.

Superintendent McPhetridge finished his report by stating that, despite the challenges the District is facing, he is confident that the community and staff will come together, and the team will work together in the best interest of the children and families.
