Position: Board appointed Budget Committee Position

About: Establishing the budget is an essential function of the school district made more effective through a collaborative process. The North Marion School Board seeks patrons who are interested in an opportunity to serve as a member of the NMSD Budget Committee

Appointment Requirements: To be eligible for appointment, the candidate must:

- (1) reside within the North Marion School District boundaries,
- (2) not be an officer or employee of the district
- (3) be a registered voter of the school district

Duration of Appointment: Three year term or to complete the term of a vacated position.

Duties: In a series of public meetings, the Budget Committee meets to review, discuss, consider additions or deletions to and approve the proposed budget presented by the budget officer. Upon completion or deliberations by the committee, the budget is recommend to the board for final approval.

How to apply - application procedure: Submit a letter of interest, and a completed candidate information form to the board secretary's office via hand-delivered, US mail or email at the address below. Applications can be picked up at the district office or visit www.nmarion.k12.or.us to download.

Desirable Qualification: An active participant in school activities or committees, civil/community service, etc.; ability to solve problems in a positive manner; ability to understand disciplined fiscal management, and ability to attend budget work session and meetings.
