

Restart "Jumpstart" 2020-2021

Why do we need a Jumpstart to restart school this fall?

Welcome back, Jacks! Even though students will not physically be in their classrooms, creating connections between staff, students, and families is our priority in the first weeks of school. During the first two weeks, teachers will focus on these goals:

1. Helping students become familiar with digital tools and resources.
2. Getting to know students' likes and interests.
3. Establishing digital classroom expectations and routines.
4. Checking for students' and families' understanding of digital tools and learning expectations.
5. Assessing students beginning levels of understanding to plan for instruction.



What can we expect from the Restart Jumpstart?

The first day of school for everyone is Wednesday, September 2nd and learning will begin right away at all levels. During the first two shortened weeks, all schools in Quincy School District will be participating in Jumpstart activities, with a focus on building relationships within each classroom and the school.

Schools and teachers will send out information soon about when and how to log in for students' first class meeting on Google Meet.

Elementary:

- Pick up school supplies and technology at your child's school (see schedule below).
- Individual meetings with teachers will be held Sept. 2-18.
- Sept. 2-4: Each day will start with a live class meeting on Google Meet to explain the on-demand activities students can work on throughout the day while teachers meet with students individually.
- Sept. 8-18: Individual meetings continue. Students will have a regular schedule of live Google Meet sessions, daily assignments, and recorded videos to access at any time. The full daily schedule, including small group instruction and intervention and extension activities will begin on September 14th.

High School:

- Pickup school supplies Tuesday through Thursday, September 8-10th, 4:00pm - 8:00pm.
- Live, online classes will begin on the first day of school in all periods of the day.
- The first week in all classes will focus on the Jumpstart goals listed above.
- School advocacy staff will contact students and families to make sure everyone has access to classes and materials and to offer supports for students experiencing barriers to learning.
