INCLEMENT WEATHER PROTOCOLS



QSD'S PLAN FOR INCLEMENT WEATHER WHILE IN REMOTE AND HYBRID LEARNING MODES

School buildings may be closed for inclement weather (snow, freezing rain, drifting snow, below zero temperatures, wind chills, etc.) and when it is dangerous to put buses on the road. The District will also close buildings when temperatures drop below -15.

Given the success we've had with remote learning, we are confident that we can switch between remote and hybrid learning this winter. Depending on the weather event and road conditions, we will follow one of the schedules below, which we hope will ensure students do not have to miss school due to inclement weather:

1

SCHEDULE

When the driving conditions are only bad in the morning:

- **Students doing 100% remote learning (at home learning):** Will continue with their normal remote learning schedule.
- **Students on AM Hybrid learning schedule (in-person learning):** Will switch to a full day of remote learning. Students will need to log into their classes in the AM and receive instructions from their teacher.
- **Students on PM Hybrid learning schedule (in-person learning):** Will continue with their normal schedule.
- **Students in grades 4-12 who are full day in-person learning due to connectivity issues:** Will be on a PM schedule.

SCHEDULE

When the road conditions are bad on country roads, but highways and main routes are ok, or when it is unsafe on all roads (county and main roads) the entire day:

ALL students will do a FULL DAY of remote learning.
