### 3. COMMUNICATIONS

#### a. Public Comments

*Breanna Lafontaine, community member*, spoke to the Board on behalf of a group of community members to support CUSD teachers. Ms. Lafontaine said teachers provide stability and have done more for the students when everything was shut down. Ms. Lafontaine also spoke in favor of teachers' salary raises.

#### b. Employee Organizations Report

##### 1. CUTA Representatives

*CUTA Co-President Sean Riordan* read to the Board and public a statement made to the teachers and site administration on a personal experience as an HMBHS teacher. Mr. Riordan said the schools have lost many students due to COVID-19 and distance learning and said that now is the moment to re-engage with our students through the best lessons. Mr. Riordan said teachers should provide engaging, productive, and positive instruction and that together they can make a year a success.

##### 2. CSEA Representatives

*CSEA President Stig Lynne* said classified staff have returned to work and that this is challenging for everybody. Mr. Lynne said staff have been working very hard to provide everything necessary for remote learning. Mr. Lynne wished everyone a healthy start of the school year.

#### c. Board Members Report

*President Kimberly Hines* said this is not the usual start of the school year, but it's always exciting to start a new year, and she said she wishes teachers and students the best. Ms. Hines gave a shout out to the Boy and Girls Club of the Coastsides for all they are doing for the students.

*Member Mary Beth Alexander* shared she participated in a California School Board Association meeting. Ms. Alexander said these meetings happen every week and that participation is good to keep members in the loop of what's going on with other districts. Ms. Alexander said it heartening to see how much is going on for the students at the state, county, and district levels. Ms. Alexander said the current situation is hard and chaotic, but, at the same time, exciting to see the positive we might see come of it.

*Member Sophia Layne* said that despite all the challenges, it is exciting to take advantage of some of the opportunities the crisis is offering, like the shifting from bringing students to education to bringing education to students and the reshaping of the district structures and procedures, school lunch applications, district app, and the website. Ms. Layne said that it is crucial to make sure that the reopening of schools has equity as a focus and that we focus on the students every step of the way.

*Member Freya McCamant* said that this is a hard time, and people feel stressed about it, and we all should be conscious and aware. Ms. McCamant said everybody should treat each other with kindness and have patience. Ms. McCamant thanked teachers and staff who have already started working, and she thanked students, parents, and community members for all the hard work and support.

#### d. Superintendent Report

Student Board Representative Caroline Dodge provided the Board and the public an update on Cunha Intermediate, Kings Mountain Elementary, Farallone View Elementary, El Granada Elementary, La Costa Adult School, Hatch Elementary, and Half Moon Bay High School's events and activities.

*Superintendent Dr. Sean McPhetridge* said the district would work to provide Spanish speaking families the tools to participate in the district remote meeting. Dr. McPhetridge encouraged people to participate in the 2020 census and said that participation in the census as well as applying for district services like free and reduced meals do not have impacts on families and does not fall under the public charge.

Dr. McPhetridge gave appreciation to families for reaching out to him, to staff for what they are doing to try to come back to classrooms to instruct students, and to the Board who have also shown resilience during these challenging times. Dr. McPhetridge also said he appreciates the spirit of partnership and commitment that Sean Riordan showed in his comments earlier.
