1 High COVID-19 Activity Level
350 or more cases per 100,000 residents over 14 day period / Test positivity >10% or WCDH recommendation
100% DISTANCE LEARNING

- Pre-12th students participate in distance learning. (Limited in-person learning for students unable to access distance learning or in greatest need of additional support)
- Buildings are open for staff access unless prohibited by the Department of Health.
- No in-person extra-curricular activities/sports

2 Moderate COVID-19 Activity Level
50-350 cases per 100,000 residents over 14 day period / Test positivity 5-10% or WCDH recommendation
MODIFIED HYBRID LEARNING

- Pre-1st grade students attend school in person on an A/B schedule.
- 2nd-12th grade students participate in distance learning.

3 Moderate COVID-19 Activity Level
MODIFIED HYBRID LEARNING

- Pre-1st grade students attend school in person. Transition to full time 5 days a week, to be determined.
- 2nd-3rd grade students attend school in person on an A/B schedule.
- 4th-12th grade students participate in distance learning.

4 Moderate COVID-19 Activity Level
MODIFIED HYBRID LEARNING

- Pre-3rd grade students attend school in person. Transition to full time 5 days a week, to be determined.
- 4th-5th grade students attend school in-person on an A/B schedule. Transition to full time 5 days a week, to be determined.
- 6th-8th grade students attend school in-person on an A/B schedule with WCDH recommendation. *Start date to be determined.*
- 9th-12th grade students participate in distance learning.
- In-person extra-curricular activities/sports may resume but must follow Governor's proclamations, WIAA guidance, and WCDH recommendation.

5 Moderate COVID-19 Activity Level
Less than 200 cases per 100,000 residents over 14 day period / 5-10% positivity rate or WCDH recommendation
MODIFIED HYBRID LEARNING

- 9th-12th grade students attend school in-person on an A/B schedule with WCDH recommendation.
- In-person extra-curricular activities/sports may resume but must follow applicable Governor's proclamations, WIAA guidance, and WCDH recommendation.

6 Low COVID-19 Activity Level
Less than 50 cases per 100,000 residents over 14 day period / <5% positivity rate or WCDH recommendation
100% IN PERSON LEARNING / WCDH RECOMMENDATION

Pre-12th grade students participate onsite with full time in-person instruction 5 days a week in consultation with WCDH and space availability.
