20 students received high school credit

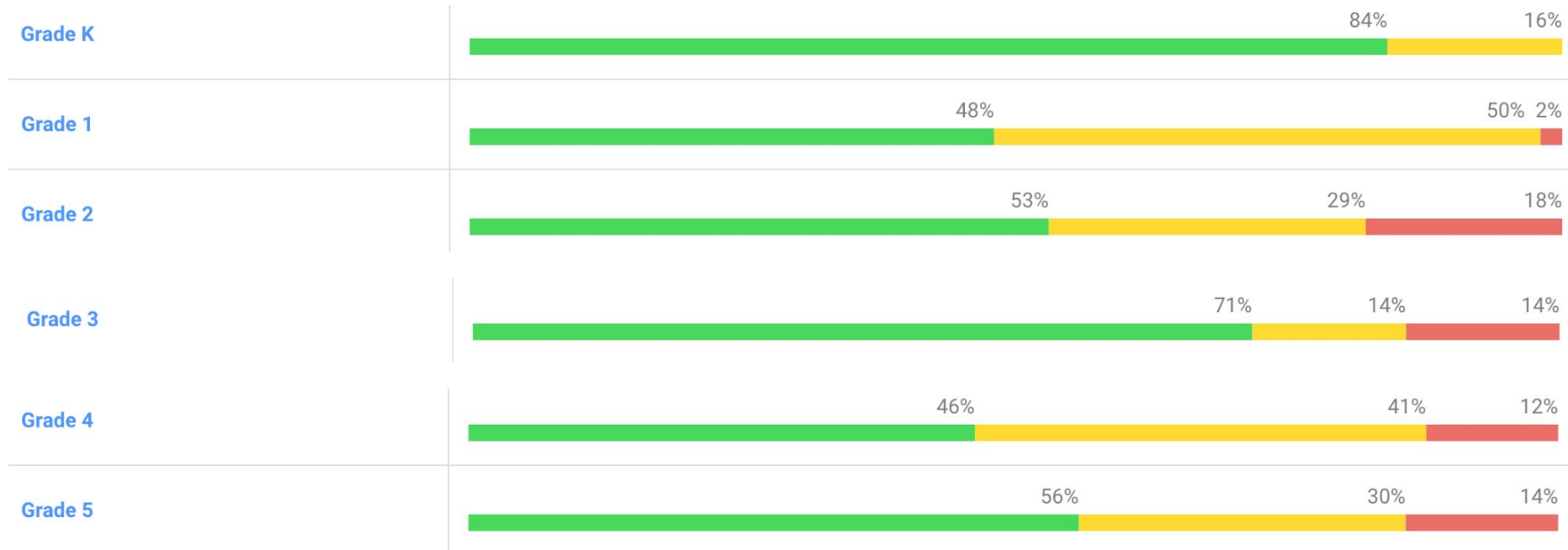

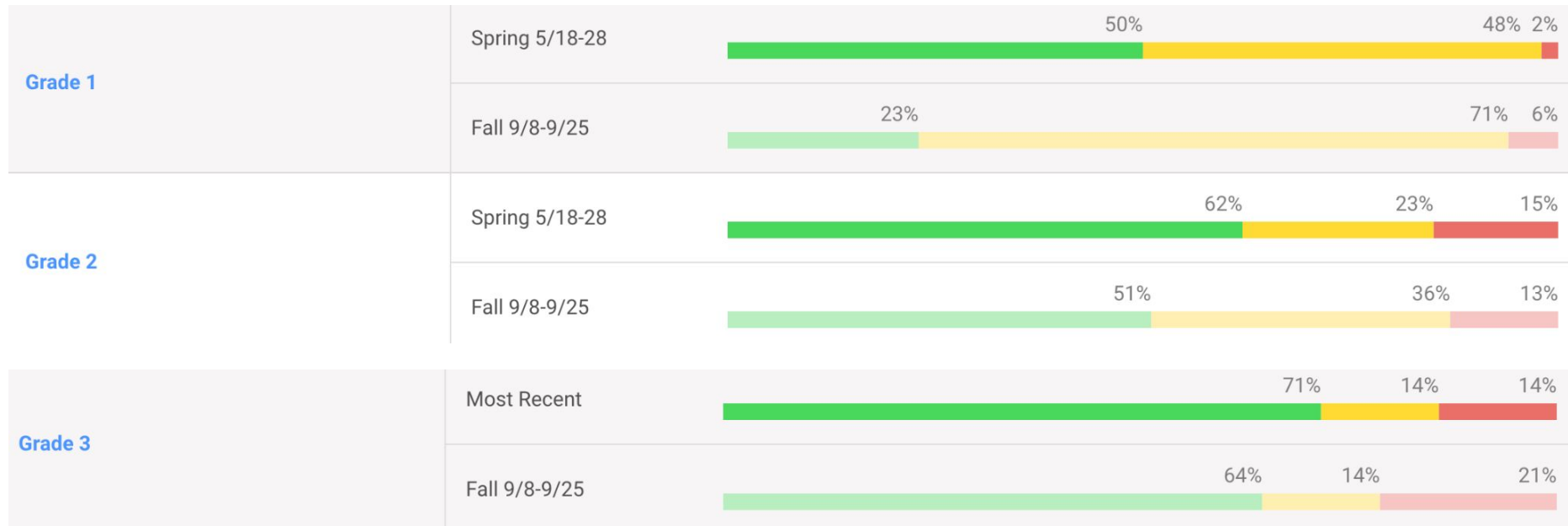

Fall 2020 - Spring 2021 Growth

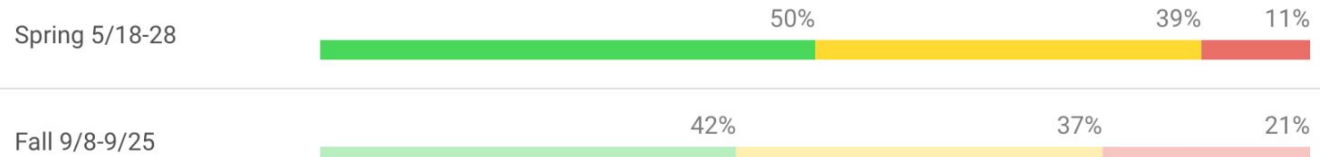

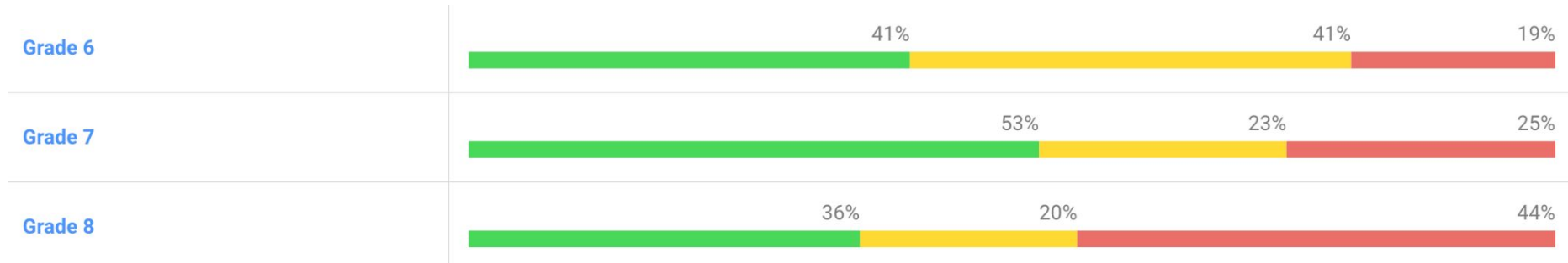

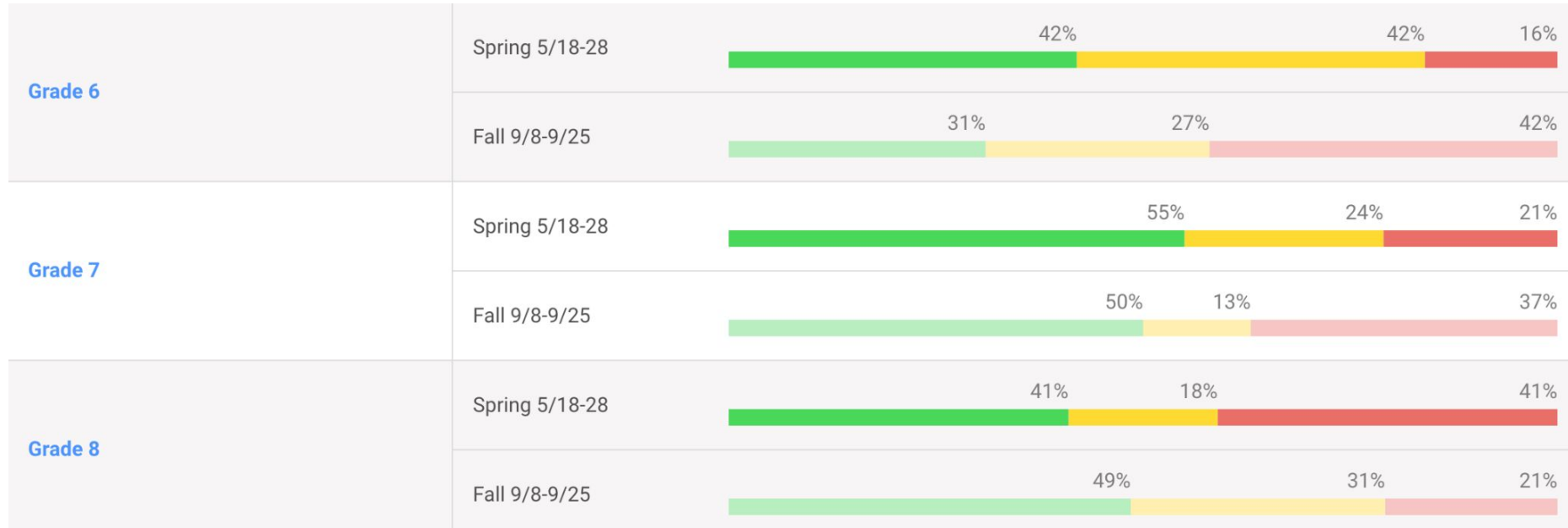

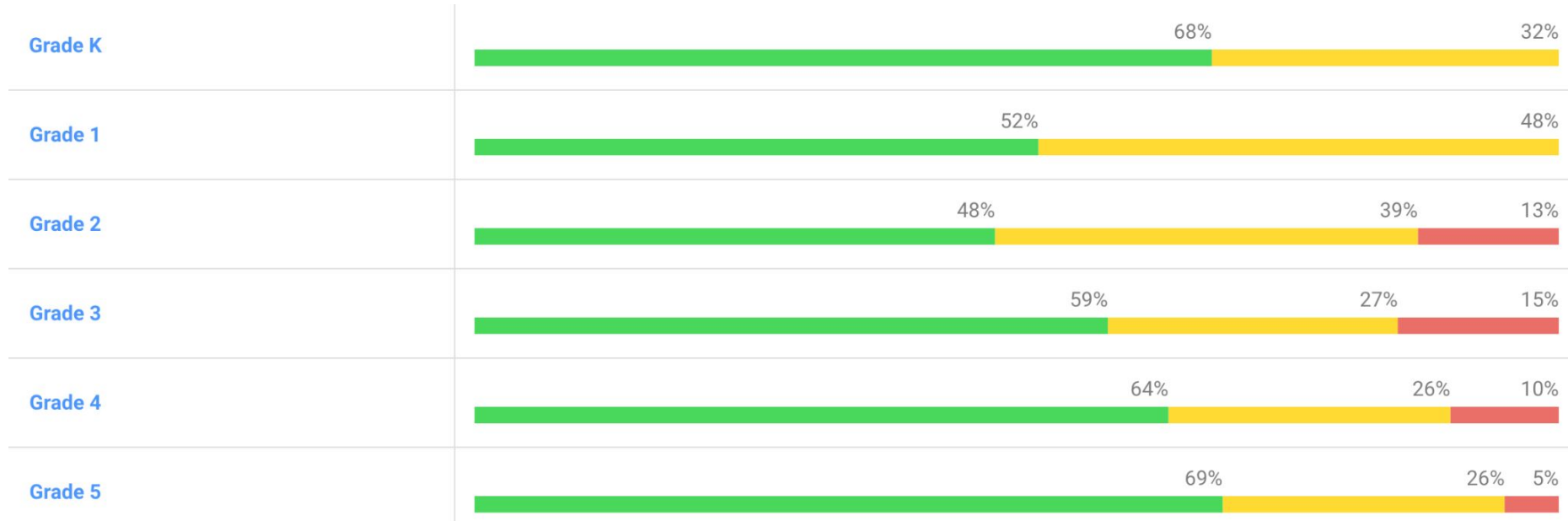
What does the data tell us?

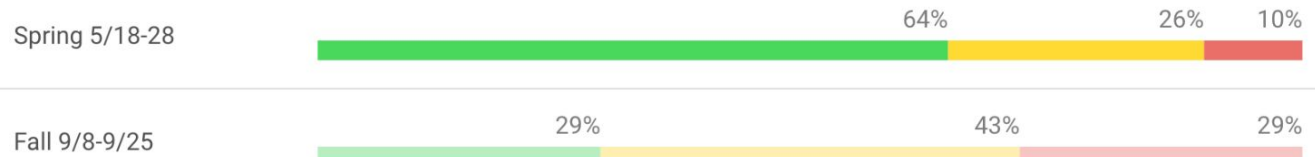

- Middle school opportunities: 6th-geometry, 7th-algebra/algebraic thinking, 8th-measurement/data
