Non-Resident District Boundary Exceptions

The board recognizes that personal and family circumstances may exist that may make it more appropriate for a student to attend a school in Shoreline and Lake Forest Park rather than a school in their district of residence. The board directs the superintendent to develop procedures to consider non-resident requests to attend Shoreline schools. The procedures must recognize that the board's first responsibility is to the residents of Shoreline and Lake Forest Park. The subsequent admittance of non-resident students, if the students are otherwise qualified, shall take into consideration the building's classroom and program capacity to serve and not diminish educational opportunities or services to Shoreline and Lake Forest Park resident students.
