Dear Parent/Guardian:

As a military community, Clover Park schools receive annual Impact Aid grants from the Federal Department of Education. Impact Aid funds are granted to school districts by the federal government in lieu of taxes to educate federally-connected students. Funds provide teachers, support staff, textbooks, classroom computers, library books and other supplies and equipment needed to support the best education possible for students.

The grant amount is based on data gathered via the confidential Impact Aid Survey. This year the Impact Aid survey will be conducted electronically. On October 3, 2023, you will receive an email from Informed K12 with the subject line "Impact Aid Survey." Please support Clover Park students by following the link and completing the survey as soon as possible, even if you do not believe your child is federally-connected.

All survey information will be **held in the strictest confidence**. Once surveying is completed and the application has been sent to the Department of Education, surveys found to be federally impacted will be secured in a vault for six years, the mandated time of record retention, and then shredded. Surveys received from parents who are not federally impacted will be shredded immediately following the application preparation.
