A. 4-A Athletic Commitment


Klayton Wyckoff, Athletic Director, gave a presentation on the athletic department. The information included in the packet compared other districts in the Big 9 to West Valley. Mr. Wyckoff made recommendations with priorities and options to the Board. There was discussion and clarification on the District budget, ASB funds, pay-to-play fee, Booster Clubs, and Title 9. Board members requested Mr. Wyckoff provide the annual average dollar other districts spend to support their athletics. The Board also requested a ratio of the number of teams of student demands and coaches by sport.
