

SAFETY PROGRAM

The superintendent shall insure that each principal supervises the operation of his/her school to assure compliance with state and federal safety and health requirements. When conditions of dis-repair or hazard appear, they shall be reported immediately to the maintenance supervisor. If conditions constitute a significant threat to the safety of students or others, school operations shall be altered to eliminate the threat with as little disruption of the school program as possible. Rules and procedures shall be developed that provide for;

- A. A safe and healthy teaching, learning, and working environment;
- B. An accident prevention program, including first aid training for supervisory staff;
- C. Compliance with state and federal safety acts;
- D. An accident reporting and recording system which shall fulfill state requirements; and
- E. Fire drills and practice in other emergency procedures.

The superintendent shall annually review with the board all guidelines and regulations dealing with the safety of students and staff and the safe operation of facilities.
