

DELEGATION OF AUTHORITY

The board of directors delegates to the superintendent of schools its responsibilities and authority to administer the district in accordance with its policies and procedures, with the exception of: establishment of district policy, purchase and sale of real estate, declarations of properties as surplus, placement of special levies and capital bonds before the public, approval of collective bargaining agreements between the district and employee bargaining groups, approval of vouchers, final approval of the operating and capital budgets for the district, and all other specific authorities reserved to the board by statute or other board policies. At the operational level, the superintendent has administrative authority of all matters affecting the school district that are not specifically reserved to the board of directors.

Unless otherwise specified, the superintendent shall have the authority to designate a staff member to serve in his/her capacity in the implementation of assigned duties and responsibilities.
