West Valley 5 Steps to Student Success

4 – 8th Graders in at least Algebra – In order for students to be able to access Advanced Mathematics and Science courses in their junior and senior years to be “College or Technical Career Ready.”

5 – Career and College Readiness – Every West Valley graduate must be prepared to compete with students from all other high schools. Research shows that the #1 Predictor of student success in college or technical school is the amount of rigor in their senior year. We want “100% College and Technical Career Ready.”
