**4. SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT**

**a. Upcoming Events and Updates**

Superintendent Dana Monogue began by honoring Bob Joers. He was a wonderful man and he touched so many lives. Administration has been discussing the potential to start school early and summer school. The district will not be able to begin early in fall due to the construction projects. The district will offer online courses for credit recovery for high school students this summer. Administration stated that we are not going to conduct the Senior Walks due to the risk of that many people together and stated that the district has done many things to honor the 2020 seniors. The high school is working on a special recognition also.

Dana stated that food provisions continue to happen at nine sites in the district. We have served approximately 26,000 meals so far. Dana also introduced Aly Xiong who will be the new Director of Employee Services. Dana did state that we will need to have a short meeting on June 8 to approve employee services items.

6. **ITEMS FOR INFORMATION/DISCUSSION**

a. **Review MHS Personnel & Process Plan**

Principal Peg Shoemaker and Director of Secondary Education Laura Love joined the meeting to discuss the structures and supports at Middleton High School. The systems/structures and collecting data around student learning will be highlighted. First, there are changes to the model for the associate principal team - all of them need to be connected to all students and understand how that connects to teaching and learning in classrooms. One of Peg's passions is increasing involvement for teachers and students. MTSS work needs to have core instruction for every student and if they don't respond to that how do we work with them and provide that intervention. MHS is still working on the first level of MTSS which is the core instruction. There were questions asked by the board members throughout the presentation along with thanks for the guidance of the high school administration during this extraordinary year.

b. **2020-2021 Enrollment Update**

Sherri Cyra presented the current enrollment for next school year. There hasn't been much change but we feel it may be due to COVID 19. Kindergarten registration is quiet at this time. Administration projected a budget increase of 104 students.

c. **2020-21 Budget Update**

The district is still in a holding pattern with the state budget. Administration will review where the district is at now and continue multiple scenario planning. There is very little information coming from the state on next year's budget.

d. **COVID-19 Update and Planning**

There was nothing formal to present tonight. Lori Ames stated we are looking at office staff and what to put in place for their return on July 1 along with planning for the return students. Perry shared we are working on a way for teachers and students to pick up materials from the buildings.

7. **ITEMS FOR ACTION**

a. **Approval of Compensation and Points Balance Scenarios**

Lori Ames explained the purpose of this agenda item and the need for approval. She provided a brief review of the compensation process in the past and stated again that we are in flux with the state budget. There were questions and discussion regarding the options.
