NOTICE

The Tacoma Public Schools Board of Directors will hold an Executive Session on the date and time above in a virtual setting, pursuant to the Proclamation by the Governor, amending Proclamation 20-05, 20-28 Open Public Meetings Act and Public Records Act.

The purpose of the Executive Session is to discuss with legal counsel, district litigation or potential litigation, to which the district is, or is likely to become, a party. Executive sessions are closed to the public.

Pursuant to the Governor's COVID-19 Emergency Orders, the Governor's Proclamation 20-28, Tacoma School Board Resolution 2074 and by order of the Superintendent, the Tacoma Public Schools Central Administration Building is closed to the public.

All regular board Business Meetings, Committee of the Whole and Study Session meetings are open public meetings and everyone is encouraged to attend.
