West Valley 5 Steps to Student Success

- 1 – Pre K – 3 Initiative - Develop a collaborative effort throughout the West Valley School District in all private pre-schools and child care facilities for better preparing all students to be “Kindergarten Ready.”
- 2 – Enriching Kindergarten Experience – The goal is to provide every child with the opportunity to better prepare for being “First Grade Ready.” Every student has the Full Day Kindergarten experience.
- 3 – 3rd and 4th Grade Students at Benchmark in Reading and Mathematics in order to participate in a more rigorous program of study and be “Middle School Ready.”
- 4 – 8th Graders in at least Algebra – In order for students to be able to access Advanced Mathematics and Science courses in their junior and senior years to be “College or Technical Career Ready.”
- 5 – Career and College Readiness – Every West Valley graduate must be prepared to compete with students from all other high schools. Research shows that the #1 Predictor of student success in college or technical school is the amount of rigor in their senior year. We want “100% College and Technical Career Ready.”
