

SCHOOL CALENDAR

In order to permit staff, students, and parents to make plans for their own work and vacation schedules, the board shall adopt a school calendar or calendars by June 1 of each year. The board recognizes the role of employee associations and the collective bargaining process in establishing school calendars. The superintendent shall establish a school calendar committee to include a variety of constituencies in developing recommendations on school calendars. Multiple calendars may be developed in order to facilitate planning over several years, and as necessary where some schools are on modified school calendars for the forthcoming school year(s). It is the board's strong preference that three years of calendars be approved and published at any given time. Following board action on school calendars, staff, students, parents, and patrons will be advised of the school calendar(s).
