

Students On Governing Boards

The Lake Chelan School District Board of Directors recognizes the value of student representation on the school board so that student voice and input is included in the board's work. The school district will annually seat three student representatives (two from CHS and 1 from CSI). With assistance from administration, student representatives will communicate with other district students to receive their input and perspectives quarterly.

Student representatives on the board are expected to attend the first board meeting of each month. The student members will contribute to board discussion by providing student insight and perspective, serve as a liaison for the associated student body, and report to students about the work of the board and district activities. Student representatives will not attend executive sessions, make motions, or hold board offices. Student representatives provide the board with advisory votes on action items as follows: immediately before the board votes on an agenda item, the student board representatives will provide their advisory vote – whether yea, nay, or abstain.
