Character Strong

This month, Omak Middle School staff are reviewing the social emotional curriculum Character Strong. Character Strong is a 6-8, 9-12 curriculum focused on character development. The curriculum provides 35-38 half-hour instructional lessons and activities for adults to build relationships between student-student, staff-student and staff-staff. The next step in the process is to gather input from neighboring school that are implementing the curriculum. If our team commits to the character strong process, a team will be sent to Chinook Middle School in Kennewick WA for a two-day training, followed by an onsite training February 14th. The Character Strong curriculum fits nicely with the skills and knowledge East Omak Elementary students are working on through the Leader in Me process.

Response to Intervention

Also this month, Omak Middle School staff are working on developing a Response to Intervention framework to support academic and social emotional instruction. The framework will provide the opportunity to intentionally teach the essential standards selected within each content area. More information to come in December.
