

Student Teachers

The procedures for developing and implementing a student teacher agreement are as follows:

1. The college representative shall present a student teacher agreement to the superintendent for review and approval;
2. The superintendent shall coordinate the institution's request for placement with principals to determine if placements are possible in the subject areas requested;
3. The college supervisor shall be notified of placements that can be accepted during the quarter;
4. Assignment shall be made with the approval of the cooperating staff member and the principal;
5. A student teacher shall preferably be assigned to a teacher with no less than three (3) years of teaching experience;
6. A supervising teacher shall not be assigned more than one (1) student teacher per school year;
7. The supervising teacher shall be responsible for the class and should not delegate responsibilities until the student teacher has displayed the proficiency to accept them; and
8. A student teacher should assume the same conditions of employment as a regular teacher in terms of length of school day, supervision of co-curricular activities, staff meetings, and in-service training.
