- 1. The district music revision work was shared with the leadership team. Music staff will be working with each other and their building principals to determine future staffing and scheduling needs.
- 2. Sexual Health Parent Night was held on 12/1 at the Junior High. The evening was a collaborative event between QSD Health Teachers, the Quincy Valley Hospital, Cross Roads, and Community Health. Parents were given a variety of sexual heath related sessions to attend.
- 3. Facility and Construction progress was sheared. Bids came in better than expected. Still need to wait for QJHS and QHS to determine alternates as process continues. By January a plan will be in place and shared with Junior High and District staff.
- 4. District Scorecard—in the process of launching to staff. The scorecard is a big picture data tool to be used to monitor student learning. The scorecard uses state and local assessment data to monitor student success. A more refined version will be forthcoming through DLT. Currently an internal document, hope for external and public use.
- 5. Building SIP work- all building goals are aligning with District Scorecard. Buildings Identified fewer goals to go deeper in the hope more will be accomplished.
