

Holidays

The district will observe the following school holidays and will not operate on these days:

1. Sunday;
2. New Years' Day (January 1);
3. Martin Luther King, Jr. Day (third Monday in January);
4. President's Day (third Monday in February);
5. Memorial Day (last Monday in May);
6. Independence Day (July 4);
- 6-7. Juneteenth (June 19);
- 7-8. Labor Day (first Monday in September);
- 8-9. Veteran's Day (November 11);
- 9-10. Thanksgiving Day (fourth Thursday in November);
- 10-11. The day after Thanksgiving; and
- 11-12. Christmas Day (December 25).

Whenever any legal holiday, other than a Sunday, falls on Sunday, the following Monday will be a legal holiday, and whenever any legal holiday falls on a Saturday, the preceding Friday will be a legal holiday.

In addition to the above, the following will also be considered to be holidays [for employees who work over 260 days a year](#): the day before Christmas, the day after Christmas and the day before New Years Day (December 24, December 26 and December 31).
