

Students on Governing Boards

Term of Office

A student representatives will be selected by the Omak High School Administration and presented to the in the spring of the year to serve on the board for the following year as the Junior Student Representative. The student representative will serve a two year term beginning in September and concluding in June. The following year, the Junior Student Representative will become the Senior Student Representative and a new Junior Student Representative will be selected.

Qualifications

The student must be entering his/her junior year at the time of selection and in good academic standing, and maintain good academic standing throughout his or her term. Selected students should also have a history of leadership and involvement in extra-curricular and civic activities.

Responsibilities

Student representatives will obey all the rules and regulations pertaining to board members. Student representatives will receive copies of all regular meeting agendas, minutes and other relevant information, excluding executive session materials.

The board may remove a student representative during the term if he/she becomes ineligible or fails to fulfill their responsibilities. In the event a vacancy arises prior to the expiration of the term, an alternate from the same school will be appointed by the school to fill the vacancy.
