

STUDENT REPRESENTATIVE(S) TO THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The Board of Directors, realizing the goal of public schools is to educate students, seeks the input and experience of students in the Port Angeles School District. Therefore, the Board of Directors has created non-voting, board positions for Student Representatives, one enrolled at Port Angeles High School and one enrolled at Lincoln High School. The role of the student representative is to:

1. Provide student insight and perspective to the Board of Directors and District administration;
2. Serve as a liaison to the students of Port Angeles High School and Lincoln High School through the established student governments and communications networks. The student representatives will work with their high school ASB/Leadership Advisor; and
3. Report to students about the work of the School District and the Board of Directors.

The student representatives will be bound by all applicable rules and regulations pertaining to the elected Board of Directors. The student representatives will participate in board discussions but will not make motions, vote, hold Board offices or attend executive sessions.
