REPLACEMENT EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS & OPERATION LEVY



February 13, 2018 – Dixie School District No. 101 will ask voters to approve a two (2) year Replacement Educational Programs and Operation Levy, replacing the expiring levy to comply with a new law regulating how districts can collect and use local levy dollars. Note: Levy relief may be available to senior or disabled citizens. Contact the Walla Walla County Assessor for details.
