



The Tacoma Public Schools Board of Directors will hold a Special Meeting on **Wednesday, August 17, 2016** at 6:00pm in the 4th Floor Auditorium at the Central Administration Building located at 601 South 8th Street, Tacoma, WA.

The Board will be meeting in Executive Session to discuss with legal counsel with legal counsel representing the district litigation or potential litigation to which the district, is, or is likely to become, a party, when public knowledge regarding the discussion is likely to result in an adverse legal or financial consequence to the district, and then will hold an open session to consider an action item regarding the Wilson High School Track/Field Project and to consider a personnel recommendation.

All regular board business meetings and study session meetings are public and everyone is encouraged to attend. Public parking and the main entrance are located on the west side of the building at South G Street.

Accessibility - The Board of Directors' meetings are accessible to all regardless of sex, race, creed, religion, color, national origin, age, veteran or military status, sexual orientation, gender expression or identity, disability, or the use a dog guide or trained service animal (a service animal is an animal that is individually trained to do work or perform tasks for the benefit of an individual with a disability).
