NOTICE

The Tacoma Public Schools Board of Directors will meet via teleconference for a Business Meeting at 6:00 PM on the date above pursuant to the Proclamation by the Governor amending Proclamation 20-05, 20-28 Open Public Meetings Act and Public Records Act. Members of the public will be able to attend this meeting virtually via live streaming on the internet locations identified above broadcast on the cable television channels identified above. All regular board Business Meetings, Committee of the Whole and Study Session meetings are open public meetings and everyone is encouraged to attend. Executive sessions are closed to the public.

The Tacoma Public Schools Board of Directors will meet for an Executive Session at 8:00 PM for approximately 1-hour on the date above in a virtual setting, pursuant to the Proclamation by the Governor, amending Proclamation 20-05, 20-28 Open Public Meetings Act and Public Records Act. The purpose of the Executive Session is to discuss with legal counsel, district litigation or potential litigation to which the district is, or is likely to become, a party. Executive sessions are closed to the public.

Pursuant to the Governor's COVID-19 Emergency Orders, the Governor's Proclamation 20-28, Tacoma School Board Resolution 2074 and by order of the Superintendent, the Tacoma Public Schools Central Administration Building is closed to the public. Members of the public should not come to the Central Administration building for this meeting. Members of the public should attend by one of the four options identified above.
